CLEARING YOUR CRIMINAL RECORD: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I clear my record if I have a pending case?

If you have an open criminal or traffic case, you will have to wait until the case is closed to clear your record.

Can I clear my record if I'm on parole or probation?

- No, not if you're on parole, but you can contact Root and Rebound for help with early termination of parole: (510) 279-4662.
- For probation, once you are more than halfway done with your probation term and you've completed any and all court-ordered classes, you may be ready to clear your record. Contact us at (800) 433-6251 or ReentryClinic@nsla.org.

If I can't clear my record, is there anything else I can do?

- Pardons and Certificates of Rehabilitation are some of your other options.
- Contact the LA County Public Defender's office at (213) 974-2811 for help with Certificates of Rehabilitation.
