

Lockout Resource Packet

If a judgment has been entered against you, it is important that you prepare for a lockout. This document outlines steps you should take before your lockout and offers resources that might help you transition.

What will happen next? If you have not already, you will receive a Notice to Vacate from the Sheriff. You will have five days to leave or be ready to leave from the time it is delivered.

When will the Sheriff come? The Sheriff can come any time after the notice to vacate expires. They generally will not come on Saturdays, Sundays, nor holidays.

What will happen when the Sheriff comes? The sheriff will likely only give you a few minutes to gather your things, and then they will change the locks.

What should I do now to prepare? If you have received a notice from the sheriff, it is important that you collect your sentimental and monetary valuables and take them to a safe place. Prepare a suitcase or bag with your essentials and keep it by the door.

Packing: Prepare boxes, trash bags, and suitcases for your move. Sort your property into five categories:

- *Throw away:* place them all inside one trash bag, then dispose of the bag.
- *Give away:* place them all inside another trash bag, then give them away.
- *Keep:* Use the boxes. Be sure to seal and number the boxes, then stack them neatly by the door.
- *Essentials:* Pack two weeks' worth of clothes, toiletries, and other necessities in a suitcase.
- *Very important items:* collect your sentimental and monetary valuables and take them to a safe place.

Below are resources for identifying shelter in emergency situations. If you are locked out and cannot stay with family or friends, there are options. If you have an operable car, the Safe Parking site near you might be an option. Safe Parking sites provide access to services, bathrooms and a safe place to stay each night. Shelters are also an option but are often fairly crowded so if you are immunocompromised, you can ask about the housing accommodations provided at each shelter. Shelters are intended for short-term, crisis housing.

Things to Think About

If you are facing an eviction, you may need to act quickly to ensure that you and your belongings are safe. Below are a couple of preliminary questions to think about as you are deciding how to move forward:

Do I have any family or friends that I could stay with while I make other arrangements?

Can I afford a storage unit to hold my things until I find a new place or will everything need to be sold?

Can I afford a hotel room or AirBnB temporarily?

What financial resources do I have access to? Can I afford to hire movers or a Task Rabbit person to pick up my things?

Would you be willing to stay in a shelter temporarily or do you have an operable vehicle that you could live out of and possibly utilize a Safe Parking program?

If you do not have family or friends to stay with or means to get a hotel room or stay in your vehicle, it is recommended that you contact a housing service provider as soon as possible to ensure that you have time to complete an intake and follow up as needed. If you can, keep a call log of places you've called and the people you've spoken with to make following up easier.

For cheaper living options, sublet groups on Facebook and ads on Craigslist can be cheaper than getting an apartment or house of your own.

Follow local service providers on social media as well. LA County's socials are used to post information about new resources as they become available.
