Our advocates also work with clients to eliminate medical debt. This work includes challenging improper insurance denials, requesting financial assistance, overturning insurance denials, filing complaints with California's Department of Managed Health Care, working directly with providers and Medi-Cal, and State Fair Hearings. By utilizing these different strategies, in 2023, HCC's advocates successfully relieved more than \$890,000 of client medical debt. In 2023, NLSLA closed 2,207 cases related to health issues.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4c, Program Service Accomplishments: provide easy-to-use information and instructions about drafting legal documents and preparing for hearings. This included 494 self-help clinics, educational workshops and trainings and outreach events held.
